Supplies

Common household items such as a spatula, bar of soap, box of tissues, votive candle, shot glass, hair clip, rubber band, stapler, CD, and remote control

Large serving tray

Large napkin or kitchen towel

Blank Paper

Pens or pencils

Clock, watch, or timer

Prize(s)

Preparation

Collect 15 common household items and arrange them on a serving tray. Cover the tray with a napkin or towel so the items are hidden from view.

Instructions

Place the tray in the center of the room. Remove the napkin or towel and give your guests 30 seconds to view the items. Cover the tray and remove from the room.

Pass out the paper and pens/pencils. Give you guests 2 minutes to write down as many items as they can remember.

When two minutes have passed, asked you guests to put down their pen or pencil. Determine which guest remembered the most items.

Bring the tray back into the center of the room and uncover. Verify that the winner correctly identified the items.

Notes

This is a great game if you don't have much time because you can use items you already have around the house.

In the event of a tie, ask each winner their date of birth. Whoever was born on the day closest to the wedding date without passing it wins. If you have enough prizes, you can elect to have multiple winners.

You can also purchase a set of kitchen utensils (salad tongs, soup ladle, etc.) or bath items (soap, lotion, candles, etc.) and use the items as a prize or present the items to the bride.

Consider having clipboards, heavy magazines, or small phone books for the guests to use as a lap desk.

If a guest finishes before the allotted time has expired and she has all the correct answers, she may be declared the winner.
