MAM The ABCs of Marriage MAM

Supplies

Pens or pencils Clock, watch, or timer Prize(s)

Preparation

Print enough copies of the attached form so you have one for each guest and a few extra. You can also use a blank piece of paper and ask your guests to write the letters "A" through "Z" I the left margin.

Instructions

Hand out copies of the form and pass out pencils/pens. Tell your guests they have 5 minutes to come up with engagement, wedding, or marriage related words for each letter of the alphabet (up to four words per letter).

When time is up, ask your guests to put their pen/pencil down. Determine who has the most words (104 maximum) and ask that guest to read their list. In case of a dispute, ask the bride to determine if the word is engagement, wedding, or marriage related.

In case of a tie, determine who has the most words for letters Q, X, and Z.

Notes

Consider having clipboards, heavy magazines, or small phone books for the guests to use as a lap desk

If you need a second tiebreaker, have your guests write their name on their paper, fold the papers in half and in half again, place in a large bowl or shopping bag, and ask the bride to draw the winner.
