Supplies

Blank paper
Pens or pencils
Clock, watch, or timer
Prize(s) – inexpensive purse, wallet, or jewelry set

Preparation

Instructions

After the guests arrive and have had a little time to mingle, ask the bride to discreetly excuse herself to the next room.

Hand out the paper and pens/pencils and ask each guest to write their name. Give the guests 1 minute to write a description of the bride's outfit. Ask them to be as specific as possible noting color, style, length, pattern, material, etc.

Collect the papers and ask the bride to return. Have her read the descriptions out loud and determine which description is most accurate. That guest wins a prize

Notes

Consider having clipboards, heavy magazines, or small phone books for the guests to use as a lap desk.

You can have the bride select more than one winner based on the number of prizes.

If several descriptions are really close and the bride is having trouble selecting a winner(s), fold the descriptions in half and in half again, place in a large bowl or shopping bag, and ask the bride to draw the winner(s).
